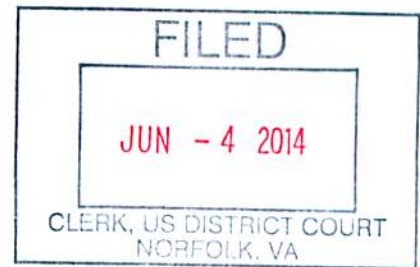

ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on Shu Quan-Sheng's ("Defendant") motion for early termination of supervised release. Doc. 58. On November 17, 2008, Defendant pled guilty to a three-count Indictment, charging him with two counts of Export of Defense Service without a License, in violation of 22 U.S.C. § 2778, and one count of Bribery of a Foreign Official, in violation of 15 U.S.C. §§ 78dd-1. On April 7, 2009, Defendant was sentenced to fifty-one (51) months imprisonment on each count to run concurrently, two years supervised release on each count to run concurrently, and a \$300 special assessment. Doc. 41.

Defendant's term of supervised release commenced on February 15, 2013. On January 18, 2014, Defendant moved the Court for early termination of supervised release. Doc. 58. On February 6, 2014, the Government filed a Response indicating it did not oppose the motion. Doc. 59.

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3583(e) and the factors reference therein, the Court **GRANTS** Defendant's Motion and **TERMINATES** Defendant's term of supervised release.
